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
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Corona Pandemic Onslaught

Appreciating this fact the USA based Shri Prafulbhai Shah, one of the founders of AT&T Technology Park and wellwishers of the PNRS suggested 'Online Training' during the misfortune. The suggestion was precious and worth-implementing but it was not very easy.

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Beginning of Pilot Project



At the end of in-depth deliberations on how to start pilot project, selection of area and its beneficiaries, how much expenses and how much success could be achieved, etc, in the Board of Trustees the project began its journey with the valued cooperation of USA-based donors and Bhavnagar-based donors. The trainees were provided laptop, dongle for internet, scanner, mouse, CDs and books after purchasing them for use at home to till completion of the training.

Solution of problems

Trainees at large were less educated, weak in English and being mostly based in rural area had hardly knowledge of computer. Thus to impart them computer training online was a difficult task. So for these trainees a one-day offline training was organised. In this training they were explained how to connect internet, how to join with faculty and how to communicate besides English words used for computer operation.



The First Beneficiaries of Online Training

Eight trainees were selected at the start of Online Training. In this batch the first trainee has been Makwana Mamta Dipakbhai who is physically handicapped and mother of two. The economic condition was poor. She stays in Vidyanagar area of Bhavnagar. When she knew that she would be given free computer training while staying at her rented home and would be given Laptop and other gadgets, her pleasure knew no bounds. Thus she could see a ray of hope for a job. Mamta completed the training successfully.




Expansion of Online Education

The functioning of pilot project attracted other disable youths to gain **Online Training** in computer. The number of beneficiaries thus increased, Again with the help of Shri Prafulbhai Shah and the USA based donors and local donors the additional requirement of gadgets like laptop, dongle, etc. were purchased in September 2020. These were distributed among new trainees at the hands of donors and Trustees.



Beneficiaries of Online Training

The disabled has to face difficulties in the daily life. For schooling the problem of to and fro for physically handicapped, for the deaf in communication and for partially blind for movement from one place to other. If family condition is poor, they face problem for study, vocational training and for starting a business without any guidance let alone to get a job. This results in losing self confidence. It is at this time they got an opportunity for taking free online computer training in AT&T Technology Park. After success of pilot project there are 130 enrollments. Thus this project has proved blessing to them specially in critical time of Corona Pandemic.



How seemingly impossible project of rendering computer training to the disable youths became possible and started?

With an aim of empowering disable youths AT&T Technology Park has been functional under the aegis of the PNRS. Its establishment in 2001 was with the financial support of AT&T Company of USA and USA based Shri Jayantbhai Shroff of Share & Care Foundation. It is a brainchild of Shri Prafulbhai Shah of Bhavnagar now in USA. When Prafulbhai Shah suggested for the first time, it seemed impossible. At that time even for normal people it was difficult to learn computer skills. But Shri Prafulbhai remained firm. With the technical guidance of Shri Jayantbhai Rajyaguru the project was commissioned.



Many Challenges were faced

As soon as the AT&T Technology Park started free computer training for the disable youths in the campus of K.L. Institute for the Deaf the disabled youths of all hues dashed to the Park and expressed desire to join, In fact, disabled of rural areas were more. Their free lodging and boarding facility was made in the campus of the K.K. School & Home for the Blind and they were provided tricycles, wooden stands, caliper to facilitate their to and fro to Park and elsewhere. To provide two meals to each was initially a challenge but the generous citizens of Bhavnagar city agreed to provide Tiffins against our appeal.



Basic to High-Level Computer Courses

Three computer labs were raised in this Park. They were equipped with 15 computers, scanner, photocopying machine, lamination machine and free Wi-Fi facility. Initially primary courses like computer fundamentals and data-entry like courses were started. As the disabled got completely aware about computer working they were imparted DTP, Photoshop, Hardware Networking, Accounting, AutoCAD, Mobile repairing courses.



Encouragement with Computer Training



Those who joined Computer Training in the Park if they were pursuing study, they were given scholarship and those have completed the courses were provided guidance for seeking job as also starting their own business besides helping them to operate new gadgets in the digital world. This is not all. Even they are assisted in taking tests of


government openings and how to face interviews. Based on the prospect of business intended by the trainee the Park administration renders them financial assistance. On completion of training awards and cash prizes are also given to the trainees.

A total number enrollment of disable youths in the AT&T Technology Park of PNRS has been 2862 from 2001 to 2020-21. During 2021-22 alone the enrollment has been 98 for different courses making total 2960. At present many of them are self-reliant and joined mainstream as respectable individuals.

Case Study

Vadher Priyanka Shaileshbhai: Native of Shihor near Bhavnagar. Priyanka is multiple disabled. She has difficulty in movement and speech. She studied in spite of poor condition of the family and got B.A. degree and now pursuing M.A. Aged 22, Priyanka's determination is unique. She felt that only degrees won't get her a job and computer skills were necessary. How can a family finding problems in normal livelihood afford computer training fees! She went to AT&T Technology Park center of Shihor and joined free computer class. Her confidence got boosted. Because of her multiple disability no one was ready to give her a job. After Basic Course completion she enrolled for DTP Course. She wants to help her family becoming self-reliant.



Dabhi Hiral Maganbhai: She hails from Sanosara village of Bhavnagar district. She became victim of disability in both legs at very young age. For pursuing study upto Std.XII her father used to take her to the school to and fro. She became B.A. as external student. She wanted to be a teacher and make her presence in the mainstream society. She initially applied her hands to activity like sewing and knitting. To get good income from such a trade in her village was difficult. For good job she has to move to cities. But in absence of proper guidance she was helpless. Aged 24 Hiral having got the information on free computer learning at AT&T Technology Park of PNRS of Bhavnagar she didn't waste any time and got the admission. The institute gave her laptop and dongle with full recharge. She took training online. She expressed her sincere thanks. She feels that this training will get her a job soon.



Milestone of Evaluation & Success

There are many examples of getting jobs after receiving computer training in the Park. Handicapped at both legs Alpesh Sutaria is working in Head Post Office of Bhavnagar, Vishal Parmar in Bhavnagar Jilla Panchayat,, Chhaganbhai Khodifad in Indian Railways and Ganava Rakesh in Sidhhi Cement, Adajan(Kutch)

Certain disable youths after computer training are running their own business. Faga Unadbhai and the deaf Bhal Hitesh after acquiring computer skills in this Park are running studio for marriage album and video editing business. Dayaben Chauhan is in RTO compound running a shop where she prepares applications and taking out prints of documents with the help of her own photocopying machine.



Those who got the success in life after receiving computer training have been described in booklet entitled 'Safaltani Chavi 'published by the AT&T Park of PNRS. This book has encouraged others to get computer training.

The ceaseless work of the team of the AT&T Park have brought in best results. Those who were trained in computer skills are no more liability to their family. Instead they joined as the earning members governing respectable position in the society. They are now part and parcel of making the healthy society.

Administration

In administration and running the Park Shri Suketubhai Shah (Project Coordinator), Shri Kaushikbhai Parmar (Administrator), Shri Mehulbhai Budheliya(Counselor) are making great efforts.
